

Prescription Drug Benefit

John Brown University Copayment Plan 2015-2016

Your Student Health Insurance Plan is set up as a Prescription Copayment Plan. This means when you go to a participating **HealthSmart Rx® pharmacy**, you will pay a \$10 Copayment for each Generic Drug and a \$25 Copayment for each Brand Name Drug. For Non-Preferred Providers, the student will be reimbursed at 60% of Usual and Customary Charges per prescription drug. Once your Non-Preferred Provider prescription is filled, you will be required to pay for your prescription in full and then file your claim for reimbursement with HealthSmart Rx®.

Show your Student Health Insurance ID card to the pharmacist. Your Copayment is listed on your ID card. If you have not received your permanent ID card, you can download a Letter of Coverage from the website at jbu.myahpcare.com.

If your pharmacy charges more than your Copayment, it could be because of one of the following reasons:

1. Your eligibility is not in the HealthSmart Rx® system*.
2. The drug you are getting is not covered under your plan.

*If your eligibility has not been loaded or you are purchasing a prescription at a pharmacy other than a pharmacy contracting with HealthSmart Rx®, you will need to pay for your prescription in full. You should contact Academic HealthPlans at (855) 850-4302 to have your eligibility loaded within 7 business days of purchasing your prescription and you may return to the pharmacy to have your prescription reprocessed. If later than 7 days or if you have purchased your prescription at an Out-of-Network provider, you will need to complete the Prescription Drug Claim Form and attach a copy of your prescription drug label along with the pharmacy receipt showing how much you paid (not the cash register receipt) for reimbursement.
