The University Student Health Insurance Plan offers a Prescription Drug Copayment Plan. To access your benefits you should use a pharmacy contracting with the HealthSmart Rx® Network. ### **For Pharmacies contracting with HealthSmart Rx® Network:**

100% of PPO Allowance after a

\$10 Copayment for each Generic Prescription Drug

\$20 Copayment for each Brand Name Prescription Drug

### **\*For All Other Pharmacies:**

60% of Usual and Reasonable Charge after a

\$10 Copayment for each Generic Prescription Drug

\$20 Copayment for each Brand Name Prescription Drug

If your pharmacy charges more than your Copayment, it could be because of one of the following reasons:

1. Your eligibility is not in the HealthSmart Rx® system\*
2. The drug you are getting is not covered under your plan

\*If your eligibility has not been loaded or you are purchasing a prescription at a pharmacy other than a pharmacy contracting with HealthSmart Rx®, you will need to pay for your prescription in full. You should contact Academic HealthPlans at **(855) 856-2384** to have your eligibility loaded within 7 business days of purchasing your prescription and you may return to the pharmacy to have your prescription reprocessed. If later than 7 days or if you have purchased your prescription at an Out-of-Network Provider, you will need to complete the Prescription Drug Claim Form and attach a copy of your prescription drug label along with the pharmacy receipt showing how much you paid (not the cash register receipt) for reimbursement.
