<b>Deductible</b>	\$75
<b>Annual Maximum</b>	\$1,000
<b>Diagnostic Evaluations<sup>2</sup></b> (deductible waived) Oral examinations (2 every 12 months)	90%
<b>Preventive Services<sup>2</sup></b> (deductible waived) Prophylaxis (2 cleanings every 12 months)	90%
<b>Diagnostic Radiographs<sup>2</sup></b> (deductible waived) Dental X-rays, full mouth (1 every 36 months)	90%
<b>Miscellaneous Preventive Services</b> Sealants/Space maintainers	90%
<b>Basic Restorative Services</b> Services for restorations necessary to repair damage caused by basic dental decay, including tooth preparation, all adhesives, bases, liners and polishing; routine fillings (amalgam and resin-based composite)	70%
<b>Non-Surgical Extractions</b> Removal of erupted tooth	70%
<b>Non-Surgical Periodontal</b> Periodic scaling and planing	70%
<b>Adjunctive Services</b> Services for palliative treatment (emergency) of dental pain, when not performed in conjunction with planned treatment; general anesthesia	70%
<b>Endodontic Services</b> Services for treatment related to dental disease of the tooth pulp	50%
<b>Oral Surgery Services</b> Surgical tooth extractions	50%
<b>Surgical Periodontal<sup>3</sup></b> Gingivectomy/gingivoplasty/Osseous surgery and grafts	50%
<b>Major Restorative Services<sup>3</sup></b> Services to restore tooth structures lost as a result of decay or fracture; single-crown restorations; inlay/onlay restorations	50%
<b>Prosthodontic Services<sup>3</sup></b> Bridges/Full and partial dentures	50%
<b>Misc Restorative &amp; Prosthodontics Services<sup>3</sup></b> Recementation of crowns, inlays, onlays/Crown repair	50%



### Important notes:

This document applies to ZIP codes that begin with the following numbers: 754-759; 764-769; 776-785; and 788-799.

All benefits are based upon the allowable amount, which is the amount determined by BCBSTX as the maximum amount eligible for payment of benefits. A contracting dentist cannot bill for charges in excess of the allowable amount. Benefits for services provided by a non-contracting dentist will be based upon the same allowable amount, and it is likely that the non-contracting dentist will bill for amounts above this, resulting in higher out-of-pocket expenses.

2. Deductible is waived.
3. A 12-month waiting period may apply. Prior continuous coverage in this plan can be applied to the waiting period requirement.
