



Prescription Drug Benefit 2016-2017

Benefits are available for outpatient Prescription Drugs on our Prescription Drug List (PDL) when dispensed by a HealthSmart Rx® Pharmacy. Benefits are subject to supply limits and Copayments that vary depending on which tier of the PDL the outpatient drug is listed. There are certain Prescription Drugs that require your Physician to notify us to verify their use is covered within your benefit.

You are responsible for paying the applicable Copayments. Your Copayment is determined by the tier to which the Prescription Drug is assigned on the PDL. Tier status may change periodically and without prior notice to you. Please access missouristate.myahpcare.com, or call (800) 681-6912, for the most up-to-date tier status.

Taylor Health and Wellness Center

- Expenses are payable at 100% (for a 30-day supply) after a \$15 Copayment for each Generic Drug
- \$30 Copayment for each Preferred Brand Name Drug (*when Generic Unavailable*)
- \$50 Copayment for each Brand Name Drug (*when Generic Available*)

HealthSmart Rx®

- Expenses are payable at 100% (for up to a 31-day supply) after a \$25 Copayment for each Generic Drug
- \$50 Copayment for each Brand Name Drug

All Other Pharmacies

- Expenses are payable at 100% (for up to a 31-day supply) after a \$50 Deductible for each Generic Drug
- \$70 Deductible for each Brand Name Drug

When you present your ID card to the network pharmacy at the time the prescription is filled, a claim will automatically be filed. If you do not use a network pharmacy, you will be responsible for paying the full cost for the prescription.

If you do not present the card or use an Out-Of-Network Pharmacy, you will need to pay the prescription and then submit a reimbursement form for prescriptions filled, along with the paid receipt and pharmacy receipt showing the prescription name, strength and dosage, in order to be reimbursed.
