Attention: Important notice on Emergency Services

Many health plans, including your UK Student Health Plan (SHP), have guidelines for what is payable in hospital emergency rooms.

Your health plan will not pay for services received in the Emergency Room if you do not have an emergency medical condition as defined in your policy.

Emergency Department treatment is very expensive. Seek care through primary care providers if your health condition allows.

As with all plan coverages, it is <u>not</u> up to your doctor to tell you when a service will be paid for through the provider company... it is *your responsibility* to understand your plan.
