## Baylor College of Medicine 2018-2019 Eligibility Guidelines

Baylor College of Medicine (BCM) requires that all students enrolled in any BCM academic programs are enrolled in the BCM student health insurance plan or enrolled in alternative coverage that meets the requirements established by the college. To waive the student health insurance plan, you must complete the online waiver by the absolute deadlines. If you do not waive coverage by the deadline, the premium will be charged to your student account. No changes will be made to a student's account after the waiver deadline.

A student must actively attend classes for at least the first 31 days after the date for which coverage is purchased, unless he or she withdraws from classes due to an Injury or Sickness and the absence is an approved medical leave. The Company maintains its right to investigate student status and attendance records to verify that the eligibility requirements have been met. If the Company discovers the eligibility requirements have not been met, its only obligation is refund of premium.
