California Institute of the Arts 2020-2021 Eligibility Guidelines

All registered **domestic and international students** taking one (1) credit are required to have health insurance coverage, either through this Student Health Insurance Plan or through another individual or family plan.

Students are automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan at registration and the premium is added to the student's tuition fees unless proof of comparable coverage is provided by completing the waiver.

All **international students** are required to have a J-1, F-1 or M-1 Visa to be eligible for this insurance plan. The premium will be added to the student's tuition fees unless proof of comparable coverage is provided by completing the waiver.

Dependent coverage is available. Payment must be paid directly to Academic HealthPlans and may not be billed to the student's account. Dependents will NOT automatically be re-enrolled. Students will need to re-enroll dependents by each semester's deadline.

The student must actively attend classes for at least the first 31 days after the date for which coverage is purchased. Home study and correspondence do not fulfill the eligibility requirements that the student actively attend classes. UnitedHealthcare maintains its right to investigate eligibility or student status and attendance records to verify that the Policy eligibility requirements have been met.
