

INSURANCE FAQS - TRAINEES AND VISITING STUDENTS

1. Who is the medical carrier?

JHU has partnered with Wellfleet to provide health insurance for all JHU students and learners beginning July 1, 2023. Wellfleet utilizes the Cigna PPO network for in-network providers.

2. How do I enroll and view my benefit information?

JHU has partnered with Academic Health Plans (AHP) to offer an online platform for all JHU students and learners to view their benefits information and add dependents to coverage. For more information, visit <u>jhu.myCare26.com</u>.

3. I had medical coverage with EHP, can I see the same providers?

Both EHP and Wellfleet use the Cigna network for in-network providers. As long as your provider participates in the Cigna network, you should not experience any disruption to your coverage.

4. Am I auto-enrolled in coverage?

No, visiting students and trainees must enroll themselves into coverage via the AHP portal, visit <u>jhu.myCare26.com</u>. You will login to the AHP site using your JHU credentials and then you will be able to enroll in medical, dental, and/or vision coverage.

5. Can I add my dependents to coverage?

Yes, you are eligible to enroll your dependents into medical, dental, and vision coverage. You will need to enroll your dependents into coverage within 30 days of your appointment date or during the annual open enrollment period, July 1 – September 15.

6. When is annual open enrollment?

The annual open enrollment period is from June 1 – September 15 each year. During this time, you can add dependents to coverage without a qualified life event.

7. When does the plan start?

The plan year for visiting students begins on 8/15/2023. The plan year for trainees begins on 7/1/2023.

8. When does my coverage end?

Coverage will end on the last day of your appointment – the date provided on your appointment letter.

9. How do I find an in-network provider?

10. Does the medical plan cover prescriptions?

Yes, Wellfleet partners with ExpressScripts(ESI) to offer prescription coverage.

11. Can I enroll a dependent outside of annual enrollment?

You must have experienced a qualified life event within the last 31 days to be eligible to enroll a dependent outside of the annual open enrollment period.

12. What is a qualifying life event (QLE)?

Some of the most common QLEs include:

- \cdot Birth of a dependent child
- \cdot Adoption/placement in home for a new child
- · Marriage
- \cdot Loss of other coverage
- \cdot Death of subscriber
- · Death of dependent
- \cdot Divorce or termination of domestic partnership
- Spouse/partner/child moving to the US with a copy of stamp on passport showing entry into the US as the date of the QLE

 \cdot Spouse/partner/child moving out of the US to their home countries for more than three months with copy of airline ticket as proof of life event.

13. How do I pay for insurance?

SOM Trainees coverage will be paid for by their department at the time of enrollment.

Visiting Students will pay AHP directly for coverage at the time of enrollment.

14. Is COBRA offered when I terminate from the plan?

CORBA is offered to trainees who terminate from the plan. COBRA is not offered to visiting students who terminate from the plan. Visiting students are eligible to extend coverage for up to an additional 3 months beyond the date in which they lost coverage. To elect an additional 3 months of coverage, please visit jhu.myCare26.com.

15. Who is the dental carrier?

JHU partners with Delta Dental to provide students and learners with access to the Delta Dental PPO + Premier network.

16. What does the Dental plan cover?
