## Lamar University 2018-2019 Eligibility Guidelines

All registered domestic students taking six (6) or more credit hours (three (3) or more during summer sessions) are eligible to enroll in this insurance plan on a voluntary basis.

Distance Learning students taking six (6) or more credit hours with at least three (3) or more credit hours on-campus credit courses and paying the Student Health Center fee are eligible to enroll in this insurance plan.

All registered international students including IEP students taking one (1) or more credit hours are required to purchase this insurance plan on a mandatory basis.

Eligible students who do enroll may also insure their Dependents. Eligible Dependents are the student's legal spouse and dependent children under 26 years of age.

The student (Named Insured) must actively attend classes for at least the first 31 days after the date for which coverage is purchased. Home study, correspondence, and online courses do not fulfill the eligibility requirements that the student actively attend classes. The Company maintains its right to investigate eligibility or student status and attendance records to verify that the Policy eligibility requirements have been met. If and whenever the Company discovers that the Policy eligibility requirements have not been met, its only obligation is refund of premium.
