

Protocol for Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure and Needlestick Injuries

For Student Health Clinic Administrators

Effective 6/1/2025

1. Submit Needlestick Incident Form – “[2025-2026 OK Student Health AB Needlestick Policy Incident Form Final](#)” to AcademicBlue_Mailbox@bcbstx.com
2. If the incident requires medication from a pharmacy:
 - a. Students should first be directed to fill the prescription at an OU Pharmacy (listed on page 2).
 - b. If the OU Pharmacy is closed or doesn't have the medication in stock, students should fill the prescription under their primary insurance coverage and expect to seek reimbursement from BCBS after the fact for any out-of-pocket expenses.
 - i. In order to seek reimbursement from BCBS, students should fill out the following form:
