To access your ID card:

1. Register on anthem.com or the Sydney Health mobile app with your student I.D.

- Print a copy of your card anytime.
- Email or fax it from your computer or mobile device.
- Show it to your doctor from your smartphone. Your digital ID card is always there and works just like a printed ID card.
