

Texas Woman's University Blood Borne Pathogen Exposure Coverage 2026-2027

Student coverage with care



Eligibility

Students enrolled in courses designated by academic component administrators as having clinical care experiences are enrolled in the plan through a fee paid upon registration in those courses.

Testing of the source person is a covered expense if a student has a blood-borne pathogen exposure. Coverage under this policy must remain continuously in force from the date of the covered accident until the date of treatment, services or supplies are received for them to be a covered expense.
