## Anthem Student Advantage 101



### Who is eligible?

You will automatically be enrolled in Anthem Student Advantage if:

- You are a Health Professional student. You will automatically be charged for the student health insurance on your student account. You need to register/ record your choice to enroll or waive the coverage by specified deadlines. There are no exceptions.
- You are an International student. You are required to maintain insurance coverage throughout enrollment at the University of Louisville. You will need to register/ record your choice to enroll or waive the coverage by specified deadlines. There are no exceptions.
- You are a Graduate Teaching Assistant or Research Assistant (GTA / RA). You will automatically be enrolled in the plan as part of your benefit package. There is no cost to you, and this plan cannot be waived.
- You are a Post-Doctoral student. You will automatically be enrolled in the plan as part of your benefit package. There is no cost to you, and this plan cannot be waived.

The following student groups are also eligible to enroll:

- Undergraduate students taking six (6) or more credit hours, all Graduate students taking three (3) or more credit hours, and CO-OP students are eligible to enroll. Classes must be on campus; online classes are not applied to the credit hour requirement.



### Coverage is available for dependents, too

If you are covered by Anthem Student Advantage through University of Louisville, you may enroll your spouse, domestic partner, or dependent children under the age of 26.
