



## University of South Carolina 2020-2021 Eligibility Guidelines

All students who meet the following criteria are considered eligible and are required to provide proof of health insurance:

- Domestic Undergraduate students enrolled in six (6) or more credit hours;
- Domestic Graduate students enrolled in six (6) or more credit hours;
- Domestic School of Medicine students enrolled in one (1) or more credit hours;
- International Graduates enrolled in one (1) or more credit hours;
- International School of Medicine students enrolled in one (1) or more hours; and
- All Graduate Students with Assistantships regardless of hours.

Students are automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan, unless proof of other comparable coverage is provided. To waive out of the Student Health Insurance Plan go to [sc.myahpcare.com](https://sc.myahpcare.com) and enter your health insurance information.

Students that are not required to show proof of health insurance and are enrolled in six or more hours and in a degree seeking program are eligible to purchase the student health insurance plan. Eligible students can voluntary enroll by visiting [sc.myahpcare.com](https://sc.myahpcare.com) and selecting the voluntary student option.
