#### **General Exclusions**

- International Students Only Eligible expenses within the Insured Person's Home Country or country of origin that would be payable or medical Treatment that is available under any governmental or national health plan for which the Insured Person could be eligible.
- Which are not Medically Necessary or do not meet Our medical policy, clinical coverage guidelines, or benefit policy guidelines.
- Received from an individual or entity that is not a Provider, as defined in this Certificate, or recognized by Us.
- Which are Experimental/Investigative or related to such, whether incurred prior to, in connection with, or subsequent
  to the Experimental/Investigative service or supply, subject to the internal and external review process. The fact that a
  service is the only available treatment for a condition will not make it eligible for coverage if We deem it to be
  Experimental/Investigative.

  - o Charges that are not documented in Provider records.
  - Charges from an outside laboratory or shop for services in connection with an order involving devices (e.g.,
    prosthetics, orthotics) which are manufactured by that laboratory or shop, but which are designed to be fitted and
