## **Am I Eligible**

## DOMESTIC AND DOCTOR OF THEOLOGY STUDENTS

All students taking six (6) or more credit hours and all Doctor of Theology students taking three (3) or more credit hours are required to have health insurance coverage and will be automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan and the premium will be added to the student's tuition fees unless proof of comparable coverage is furnished by September 30, 2022.

#### **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

All International students taking one (1) or more credit hours are required to have health insurance coverage and will be automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan and the premium will be added to the student's tuition fees unless proof of comparable coverage is furnished by September 30, 2022.

If you no longer meet the eligibility requirements contact Academic Health Plans at dts.myahpcare.com prior to your termination date.

#### Dependents

Insured Students who are enrolled in the Student Health Plan may also enroll their eligible Dependents.
