

# Western Kentucky University Prescription Drug Benefit 2020-2021



Benefits are available for outpatient Prescription Drugs on our Prescription Drug List (PDL) when dispensed by a UHCP. Benefits are subject to supply limits and Copayments that vary depending on which tier of the PDL the outpatient drug is listed. There are certain Prescription Drugs that require your Physician to notify us to verify their use is covered within your benefit.

You are responsible for paying the applicable Copayments. Your Copayment is determined by the tier to which the Prescription Drug is assigned on the PDL. ## **UHCP:**

Expenses payable at 100% after a  
\$20 Copayment per prescription Tier 1  
\$35 Copayment per prescription Tier 2  
\$60 Copayment per prescription Tier 3  
up to a 31 Day Supply

## **All Other Pharmacies:**

Expenses are paid at 100% after a  
\$20 Copay per prescription order or refill for a Generic Prescription Drug  
\$35 Copay per prescription order or refill for a Brand Name Prescription Drug  
up to a 31 day supply.

When you present your ID card to the network pharmacy at the time the prescription is filled, a claim will automatically be filed. If you do not use a network pharmacy, you will be responsible for paying the full cost for the prescription.

If you do not present the card or use an Out-Of-Network Pharmacy, you will need to pay the prescription and then submit a reimbursement form for prescriptions filled along with the paid receipt and pharmacy receipt showing the prescription name, strength and dosage in order to be reimbursed.
